Open

• For this week's group time, we are going to be using the ancient Christian practice of *Lectio Divina* ("spiritual reading"). This practice is one way of praying through a text of Scripture, and we will use it to pray through Ephesians 3:14-21.

The questions below are for your group to discuss afterwards.

Discuss

- What word or phrase did God bring to your attention, and what feeling did that word/phrase provoke in you?
- Discuss what happened for you during your time of silently talking with God about this word/phrase and feeling. What insights
- As you have listened to the other group members talk, what thoughts or feelings has that surfaced in you?

Reflect

- Overall, which parts of *Lectio Divina* were easier for you, and which parts were more difficult? What do you think about this practice?
- How might you use the practice of *Lectio Divina* in your daily quiet time?
- What questions or observations do you have regarding this prayer practice?
