- How does obedience to Jesus' commands help "create the space" for us to be transformed? How does obedience help us better "see the kingdom of God"?
- Read Colossians 3:1-17. How does this passage relate to the discussion between Jesus and Nicodemus in John 3?

Reflect

- What is one thing that you feel God is leading you to do this next week in light of today's discussion?
- Based on today's discussion, how can the group pray for you?
