Open

- What is the most memorable sermon you've ever heard?

Discuss*

- Is there something unique about the sermon as a method of gospel proclamation? Why or why not? (Do you think God views the sermon any differently than he does other methods of gospel proclamation?)
- What type of authority do you feel the preaching of God's Word has in the church today when compared to the past?
- Why do you think we rarely connect the idea of the power of God on display to the sermon?
- Peter's sermon in Acts 2 demanded action. How often do you respond to sermons with action? Why?
- When was the last time you felt God speak to you through a sermon? What did he say?

Reflect

- How do you expect God to move you on Sunday mornings? What can you do to raise your expectation level?
- Based on this discussion, what should we pray about?
