- What kinds of things have helped you in your struggle against unbelief?
- Did you discover anything new about Mary in this text that you had not considered before?
- What is a phrase or word in this passage that stood out to you?
- Is there something in this example of Mary that you would like to emulate?
- It is unlikely that any of us will be visited by an angel. How might we be able to determine God's call for us today?
- Based on this passage, how should we pray?
