After watching the video...

1. Why do you think Paul is so intent on emphasizing the bodily (physical) resurrection of Jesus?
2. How does Jesus's bodily resurrection speak specifically to you at this point in your life? What difference does it make to you, and why?
3. Why do you think the kinds of people Jesus appeared to (e.g., church leaders, followers of Jesus, skeptics of Jesus, and enemies of Jesus) are so important? In what ways does this encourage and challenge you with regard to the different kinds of people in your life (e.g., your leaders, those you lead, those who don't trust you, those who you would call your enemies)?
4. What is one thing you think the Holy Spirit may be saying to you in light of this passage?
5. Based on *these verses*, what should we pray about?
